Rules and Regulations



The Oregon Park District will host an afternoon of local teen talent on **Friday, June 19th, 2010 at Oregon Park West Bandshell**. Spots are limited, so interested bands must fill out the attached entry form and submit it beginning March 1, 2010 to the Oregon Park District, Nash Recreation Center. Bands will be selected in the order the completed entry forms are submitted. **Registration deadline for the 2010 Battle of the Bands is June 12, 2010.**

- First priority will be given to bands who have at least one member who resides within the Oregon Park District.
- Bands must consist of at least two members, one of which plays an instrument throughout the majority of the performance. Band must be unsigned and the entire performance must be live.
- Band members must be between the **ages of 12-21** (half must be no older than 19 years of age as of August 15, 2010).
- Each band member under the age of 18 must have a parent signature on the entry form to participate.
- In the event that more bands submit an entry form than spots allow, some bands may not have the opportunity to participate in this event. **Bands will be notified of their acceptance.**
- Band name and lyrics of performance songs must not contain any obscenities. The entire performance must be violence-free and suitable for a family audience. This includes, but not limited to, language, gestures, body movements and/or innuendoes. **A copy of all lyrics must be submitted to the Event Coordinator (at Nash Recreation Center) no later than June 12th, 2010.**
- The band members must supply any musical instruments and equipment not provided by the host site. A sound system may be available at the local competition. Band members are responsible for the security of their equipment and the event organizers cannot be held liable for any lost, damaged, or stolen equipment.
- All bands will receive an equal amount of time on stage (determined based on the number of entries). This time includes all set-up, playing, and take-down time. A drawing will be held to determine the time-slots assigned and order of competition.
- On the day of the performance, band members must be dressed in clothing free from obscenities, drugs, alcohol, sex, or any other subject matter not suitable for a family audience.
- Drugs, alcohol, and tobacco are not permitted on the host site property during the Battle of the Bands Competition (local, regional or state).
- There may be a required band/organizer meeting prior to the performance. Bands will meet the organizers in charge of the event and go over last minute announcements. Bands may unload equipment at that time. All bands must be present again at the end of the performances for the announcement of the winners.
- If a band incites moshing or any other sort of violence in the crowd, the band will be disqualified because they are putting people in the crowd at risk.
- Fires, pyrotechnics, fog machines, etc. are not allowed.
- When a band is done performing, they are expected to allow the next band to get on stage as quickly as possible.
- A panel of judges will score musicians using a point system. Criteria to be considered may include: Stage Presentation, Sound Volume & Clarity, Band Synchronization, Time Management, Song Quality & Originality, Stage Management, Band Enthusiasm & Attitude, and Audience Response.
- All bands agree to have their name, voice, and/or photos used in any advertising or broadcasting material relating to this contest without any compensation or rights to royalties for such use.
- The Oregon Park District reserves the right to make changes to the rules and regulations of the competition, as well as the final word in any disputes that should arise concerning this event.
